


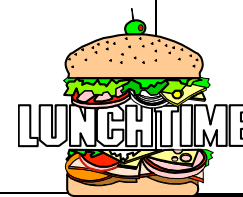

CAFETERIA NEWS

Please be sure your student has their lunch money each day or pay on a weekly/monthly basis on account. **No lunch charges will be permitted.** When money is forgotten, students will be permitted to phone someone to bring them money. We ask for your cooperation.

Revised Cafeteria Procedures

- 1) Unless parents send a note specifying a request for change from a large bill, all money will be deposited in the students lunch account.
- 2) Students will be permitted to go through the lunch one time. They need to remember to pick up all food items & snacks at that time. Students will be limited to 2 snacks.
- 3) Lunch & snack money are to be collected by the Teacher each morning and will be deposited into student lunch accounts.
- 4) A report, showing account balance, will be sent home with the students.
- 5) As a reminder, parents can send in a written request that their child not be allowed to buy snacks or breakfast.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM THE OFFICE
